2007 WORTHAM GROVE SWIMMING POOL RULES

Listed below are the pool rules for the 2007 swimming season. Please make sure you read these rules and that everyone in your family is aware of them. Remember, the guards are responsible for the enforcement of each rule and have ultimate authority in the enforcement and discipline in order to maintain expected safety standards set by the industry and the Board of Directors of WORTHAM GROVE. Please help make this the best year ever.

- I. Lifeguards **must be obeyed** at all times. **They have the authority to remove persons endangering anyone or violating pool rules.** The pool company will keep any pool tags that they deem necessary (i.e. tags obtained with false information, un acceptable behavior by tag holders or their guests).
- 2. No excessive talking with the guards while they are on the stand.
- 3. Only lifeguards are allowed in the pump room and office.
- 4. There will be a 10-minute rest period for the guards every hour, at 10 minutes before the hour except for the last hour. Only adults 18 years or older may swim at this time.
- 5. Head lifeguard on duty has full authority to limit the number of people in the main pool to the maximum ratio allowed for lifeguards on duty,
- 6. All persons must check in with a lifeguard before entering the pool.
- 7. Pool tags must be worn by those age 12 and older and visible in the pool area at all times.
- 8. Swim suits only! NO SHORTS OR CUT OFFS!
- 9. No running or excessive horseplay. (Exces sive will be determined by the guards on duty)
- 10. No loud, abusive or vulgar language at any time.
- 11. No pets in the fenced pool area.
- 12. No hard balls in the pool area. Large floats are discretionary.
- 13. No knives or weapons of any kind in the pool area. Weapons will be determined by the guards on duty. If discovered, the lifeguard will call law enforcement immediately.
- 14. No electrical appliances. Battery-operated radios are permitted at a very LOW volume.
- 15. No glass items in the pool, pool a rea, under pavilion, or in the park.
- 16. No food, drinks or gum in the immediate pool area (within three feet).
- 17. No alcoholic beverages allowed during scheduled pool hours.
- 18. No wheeled vehicles allowed (except wheelchairs, wagons and baby stroller s).

- 19. No loitering in the pool area "pool area" includes under tower.
- 20. Persons with an injury (such as open cuts or sores) are not allowed in the pool. Persons wearing bandages are not allowed in the pool. Infants/toddlers wearing diapers must w ear protective covers.
- 21. Guardian of non-swimmers 12 years and under must be in the pool with non -swimmer at all times.
- 22. Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- 23. Children must be 4 years or younger to use the baby pool and must be supervised by an adult. There must be at least one adult to every three children.

WORTHAM GROVE SWIMMING POOL ADMISSION RULES

ALL RESIDENTS MUST SIGN IN

- 1. Only residents of WORTHAM GROVE, who have complied with the registra tion procedures will be allowed admittance to the pool and pool area.
- 2. Guests may be brought by a resident who is registered under the following conditions:
 - A. One guest per name listed on registration form, up to four MAXIMUM per address.
 - B. More guests may be allowed during off-peak hours by lifeguard, at their discretion, depending on the number of people in the pool.
 - C. Guest(s) must not be a resident of WORTHAM GROVE.
 - D. Guest(s) must leave when the homeowner leaves.
 - E. The homeowner will be billed for lost pool tags.

Parties are to be arranged with Sweetwater Pools and not held during regular pool hours.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult

No loud music around pool area

No plug-in electrical appliances are allowed in the pool.
